

Using Portable Electric Fencing
in the Back country

- Practice at home first
- Both solar and battery power chargers are available
- Keep materials light weight and compact for easy packing
- Use wide tape/wire for high visibility. Keep in mind wildlife (elk, deer, etc.) may run into, and knock down your fence line. If other campers are in the area, use flagging/warning signs on fence line
- Take advantage of existing trees, bushes, fence post, etc. to allow for more space. Use fishing line or string and attach to your tape/wire to natural, stationary objects.
- Move frequently if camping in the area for more than 2 days
- If necessary, hobble equines who are high risk for wandering
- Spread manure and restore area before you leave
